
## **GRA Worksheet #3: Past Simple or Present Perfect Simple**

- 1. The chart shows the percentage of American students who (use) illicit drugs since 2000.
- 2. The proportion of female students who have ever used illicit drugs (increase) by more than 50% since 2000.
- 3. In 2010, the percentage of American male students reported to be using drugs (rise) to 50%.
- 4. From the graph we can see that illicit drug use among American female students (rise) each year.
- 5. The percentage of male students who used illicit drugs (be) greater than the percentage of female students from 2000 to 2010.
- 6. However, American female students (overtake) male students in drug usage since 2010.
- 7. The overall drug-use rate among American students (grow) each year and the most significant rise (occur) between 2000 and 2005.
